NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AN OPERATIONAL CERTIFICATE 107689 UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT

Take notice that the Director intends, a minimum of 30 days after the last date of publication of this notice, to issue an OPERATIONAL CERTIFICATE 107689 to Upland Excavating Ltd. (Upland) for a landfill located at 7295 Gold River Highway, Campbell River, BC V6H 1P1.

The land upon which the facility is situated, and the discharge occurs, is a portion of the property as defined by PID 001-223-321, LOT A, DISTRICT LOT 85, SAYWARD DISTRICT, PLAN 30709 EXCEPT PART IN PLAN EPP15087, within the City of Campbell River.

The existing landfill is included in the Comox Valley Regional District Comox Strathcona Waste Management 2012 Solid Waste Management Plan which was approved by the minister on May 23, 2013. The operational certificate would supersede and cancel the existing Permit PR-10807 issued under section 14 of the Environmental Management Act.
